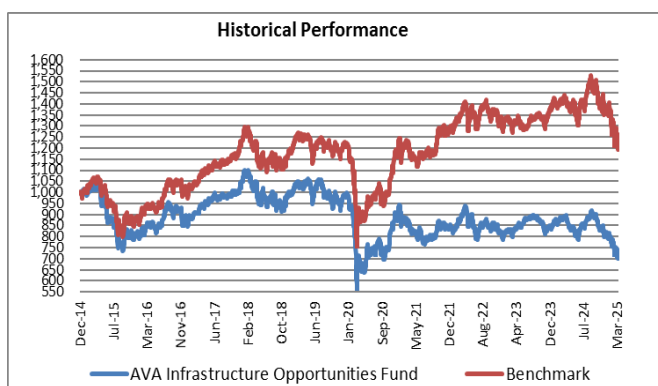

MARKET UPDATE

The Jakarta Composite Index (JCI) rose 3.8% after an -11.8% correction in the previous month, Foreign investors still recorded outflows of -USD489.7 million, albeit much lower compared to -USD1.1 billion in the previous month. These outflows were due to continued concerns over policy uncertainty and inflation related to the US tariff war narrative. There were also concerns over domestic policies. The launch of Danantara raised concerns over governance and its impact on SOEs and the banking sector. The technology sector (+21.5%) remained the outperformer in March, while the cyclical consumer sector (-7.4%) was the worst performer. Concerns over US tariffs and domestic policies are fuelling market volatility. However, Indonesia's strong fundamentals (e.g. low dependence on exports) and lower interest rate cycle may support foreign investors' interest in Indonesia in the medium-to-long term. The Indonesian stock market is trading at attractive valuations, much lower than its average in the last ten years.
