As per 31 December 2025, the Risk Based Capital ratio of PT Asuransi Jiwa Astra reached 382% with unit link fund assets and pension fund assets amounted to Rp 3.00 trillion and Rp 4.06 trillion respectively.

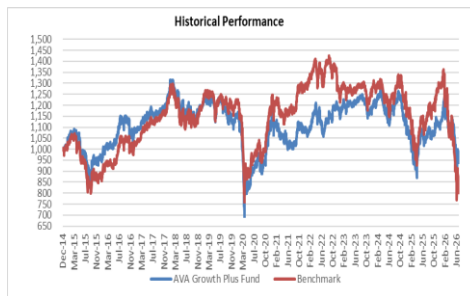

MARKET UPDATE

In the month of June 2026, IDX80 posted a return of -10.60% MoM. Indonesia equity market experiences a sharp volatility and turbulent led by weakening currency, declining market liquidity, and MSCI decision on Indonesia's EM status. JCI briefly dropped to its 5 years low level near 5,300 after Rupiah breached 18,000 level and sentiment worsened due to policy uncertainty and fiscal concern. However, JCI saw a rebound in mid-June driven by a surprise off cycle rate hike by Bank Indonesia to stabilize the currency, peace agreement in the Middle East which alleviate fiscal concern due to declining oil price, and government scaling back its priority program target for the free lunch program (from IDR335tn to IDR228tn) and village cooperative program (cut half to 40k from 80k). However, during the last week of June, the rally faded after MSCI decided to delay their decision on Indonesia's country status in the Emerging Market until November 2026. While acknowledging the regulator's recent efforts for capital market reform, MSCI continues to be concerned on market transparency issues and potential coordinated trading activities; noting that the consistency, implementation, and sustained effectiveness of these reforms remain as key consideration in upcoming deadline. The top contributors to IDX80 are Sumber Alfaria Trijaya/AMRT (+22.84%), Unilever Indonesia/UNVR (+13.31%), Kalbe Farma/KLBF (+2.15%), Mitra Keluarga Karyasehat/MIKA (+7.25%), and Mitra Adiperkasa/MAPI (+2.01%). While the top detractors of IDX80 are Telkom Indonesia/TLKM (-16.12%), Barito Pacific/BRPT (-33.76%), Astra International/ASII (-9.60%), Bumi Resources Minerals/BRMS (-20.34%), and Bank Negara Indonesia/BBNI (-14.59%).
