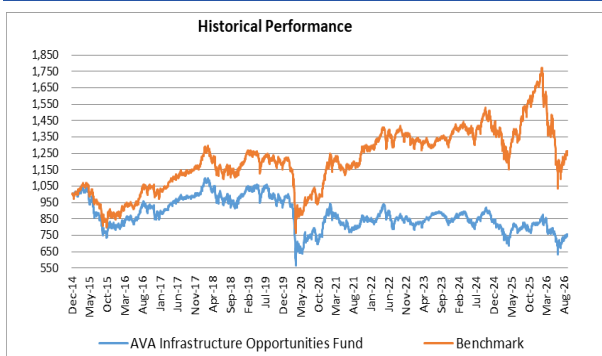

MARKET UPDATE

In the month of August 2026, JCI posted a return of +4.64%. Sentiment improved meaningfully as investors gained confidence in Indonesia's policy mix. The government's proposed 2027 fiscal deficit of 2.4% of GDP, the lowest since 2024, reinforced perceptions of fiscal discipline, while Bank Indonesia (BI) signaled a more accommodative stance by maintaining the policy rate at 5.75% and sharply reducing SRBI issuance from Rp116 trillion in July to Rp49 trillion in August. This liquidity injection helped ease domestic financial conditions and supported risk assets despite a challenging external backdrop characterized by rising yields and renewed expectations of further Fed tightening. A notable feature of August's rally was that it occurred despite continued foreign equity selling. Foreign investors recorded another US\$200 million net outflow, bringing cumulative YTD foreign equity outflows to US\$5.6 billion.
